Cape May is home to a variety of restaurants, from walk-up hot dog stands to world-class dining! Below is a list of some restaurants, a dinner show option, and a couple of options for transportation.

Please note that late October is considered "off-season", with many restaurants closed for the season or closed on weekdays. The following list are some suggestions for restaurants who have indicated they will be open for business. It is STRONGLY suggested that make a reservation for your group. Many Cape May restaurants are small in size, and may have limited seating especially for larger parties.
